- BMG is a Primary Care Network that provides care to approximately 54000 patients
- The practice operates out of 5 different sites
- Well-developed extended team



- Prior to November 2023 Discussion with BMG and UHMBT regarding support for an FCP Paediatric Dietitian
- Already 2 FCP Adult Dietitians in post employed directly by the practice
- Paediatric Dietetic FCP role at the Bay Medical Practice commenced on the 1st November 2023
- Initially a Pilot until 30th June 2024 this has now been extended
- Current SLA with the BMG 8 hours per week

Cows Milk Protein Allergy





- Cow's milk protein allergy (CMPA), affects around 2-5 % of infants in the U.K
- CMPA is one of the most common food allergies
- CMPA has a varied and broad presentation, making it extremely hard to diagnose.
- CMPA tends to resolve in most infants, with 50% of allergies resolving in the first year of life and 80-90% having resolved by the time the child is five years old

Cows Milk Protein Allergy





- Nationally, prescriptions for specialist milk formulas used to treat this allergy has increased by 500% between 2006 and 2016, from 105,029 to over 600,000.
- This increase in prescriptions increased spending, from £8.1 million annually to over £60 million, highlighting the impact CMPA has on the NHS.
- Cost of specialist infant formula:-
- 400g of Neocate £24.82, 400g of Aptamil Pepti £9.86. Difference per tin £14.96. Average prescription 8 x 400g tins each month.
- Average number of tins per month 8-12 x 400g tins.
- If prescribed 12 x tins of Neocate per month £297 per month
- If prescribed 12 x tins of Aptamil Pepti per month £118.32 per month

Cows Milk Protein Allergy - Evaluation





Aim

- Review the number of patients receiving a specialist infant formula on prescription at Bay Medical Practice
- Review the patient's requirement for prescriptions of specialist infant formula

Cows Milk Protein Allergy Evaluation





Methodology

- Requested list of all patients prescribed a specialist infant formula
- List split into 2 dependent on age
- Initial focus was on children over the age of 1 year
- Each child's notes reviewed and parents contacted if:-
 - Specialist infant formula continue to be prescribed over the age of 1
 - Not reviewed by a Dietitian/ Paediatrician within the last 6 months and/or no correspondence regarding the prescription formula
 - Family contacted initially by Accurex asking the family to book an appointment to review prescription of specialist infant formula
- If appointment not made contacted the family by telephone

Cows Milk Protein Allergy Evaluation



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Methodology

- Second phases concentrated on infants under the age of 1
- · Each child's notes reviewed and parents contacted if:-
 - Specialist infant formula continue to be prescribed
 - Not reviewed by a Dietitian/ Paediatrician
 - No documentation of a challenge
 - Family contacted initially by Accurex asking the family to book an appointment to review prescription of specialist infant formula
- If appointment not made contacted the family by telephone

Prescription of infant Formulas at BMG





Results

- 32 children over the age of 1 were prescribed specialist infant formula. Of those 32 patients, after a review only 2 are now prescribed a specialist infant formula
- 18 (56%) patients over the age of 1 were prescribed an amino acid-based formula
- 41 infants under the age of 1 were prescribed a specialist infant formula and 11 stopped following review.
- 41% of infants under the age of 1 were being prescribed an amino- acid based formula and 11% changed to a
- 90% of infants should respond to an EHF
- Therefore 31% (13 patients) of infants are potentially being prescribe an Amino Acid based formula when they should respond to an extensively hydrolysed formula.

Evaluation


- Positive Significant cost saving
- Some families were grateful for the phone call as 'they had felt completely lost' and 'didn't know when to change the formula'
- Some concerns about complaints/challenge to stopping prescription formula, but none received
- Is this the role of the FCP Dietitian?

Appointments



 FCP Paediatric Dietitian has been working at the BMG for 24 weeks. There have been 175 available appointments with 151 filled appointments. 87% of appointments filled

Type of Appointment




- 104 (69%) new appointments offered


